

Cow Summary & Monitor Reports

The Cow Management report allows you to follow the progress of individual animals.

The Cow Monitor report offers the same information as the Cow Summary, with added opportunity to choose 4 columns of information from the 28 choices:

Cow Rating	Peak Milk	Change from Last Test (BCAM)
Daily Fat & Daily Protein Yield	Protein:Fat Ratio	Lactation Fat & Protein yield
Days Dry	Days Open	Days Bred
Times Bred	Days Pregnant	Reproduction Status

How Do I use the Reports Effectively?

The Cow Summary and Cow Monitor reports show current test day & lactation production information for individual animals. The reports can help find the animals that may need attention. Consider the following:

- 1) Test Day Data: check to see how many animals have Fat % or Protein % less than 3.0%. What stage of lactation are they?
- 2) BCA: how many animals have a large (-) for BCAM. What is the reason? If it is not explainable, consider culling.
- 3) Lactation Information: how many animals have DIM greater than 370? Why are they milking so long? Was the late DIM at pregnancy a result of reproductive problems?
- 4) Other: How many animals have days open greater than 150. Why?
- 5) Optional Columns: Which animals do not meet your minimum requirements? Is there a reason?
